**Family Reading Time**

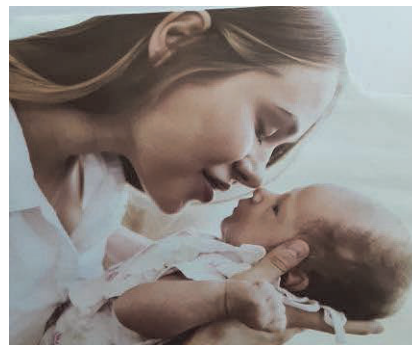
A recent study by Catherine Pakaluk studied the “Birth Dearth”, the current trend of collapsing global populations in the world in general and Western nations in particular. The “fertility rate” (number of children per woman) has dropped more than 50% in the past 70 years, to a point where more than half of all countries (including the United States) have a fertility rate of less than 2.1 which is the replacement number for sustaining a stable population.

Families are where children learn values essential to creating strong communities and society in general. Even the New York Times (4/24/12) admitted that strong families create “stronger schools, stronger churches, and stronger communities with less poverty and less crime.”

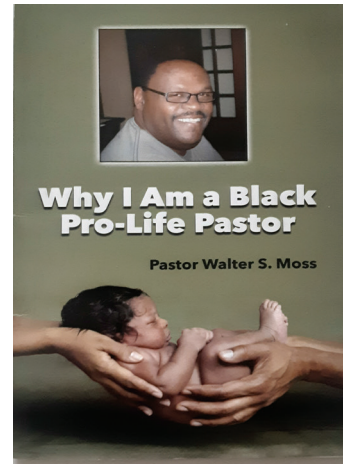

**Good News!**

The *Arkansas Dept. of Health’s Vital Statistics* reported that no abortions occurred in the state during 2023.

The *Indiana Department of Health* released its official abortion report for the first quarter of 2024. The report shows 98% decrease in abortions in the first quarter of 2024 (45 abortions) compared to the first quarter of 2023 (1,931 abortions).

*West Virginia’s* abortions have also dramatically declined by 98% since the Supreme Court Dobb’s decision overturning *Roe v. Wade*.





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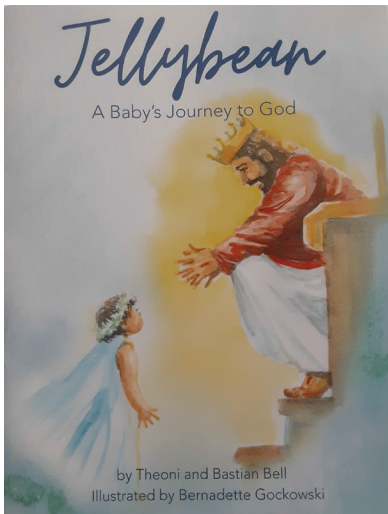
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**RECOMMENDED BOOK**
